ACTIVITY OVERVIEW

MATERIALS

Paper and drawing supplies (markers, crayons, or colored pencils)

DIRECTIONS

1. Take a blank piece of paper and sketch out a website design for your class or school. Be sure to include a title, a picture, and one sentence describing the subject.
2. Use the examples from the interactive eBook *What Is HTML Code?* to translate your design into HTML.
3. With a partner, check your work and debug each other's code.
